

Hi Everyone, It's time to reclaim your booth(s) for the 31st Annual Children's Fair!

The fair is Sunday, April 24th from 12 Noon – 5:00pm at Unidad Park or Kirby Park. Unidad Park playground is being worked on by the city and might be completed by the time we are setting up for the Children's Fair, but we do have Kirby Park reserved if we are unable to use Unidad Park.

As always, you may keep the same booth(s) as long as you let us know by Friday, February 18th. On February 21st, we open registration to other organizations that may take your booth from last year – so be sure to let us know! Please fill out the registration form and provide the necessary information to reserve your spot today.

We will be looking to continue to improve from last year which was our first year to lead the event. We have learned a lot and will push hard to make this one even better. After the fair, tickets will be turned in and we will figure out how much your booth(s) took in based on your reported ticket count. San Angelo YMCA will retain 15% and then deduct \$25 per booth at that time. The remainder will be sent to you shortly after the Fair. For profit, non-ticketing booths will be charged \$100.

ONCE AGAIN, BOOTHS WILL MAKE THEIR OWN SIGNS: We will provide you with the 2'x 3' white cardboard, with the Sponsorship sticker attached, to create your own sign(s). All you have to do is color them, bring them to the park the day of the fair, and we'll provide you with zip ties to attach them to the metal fence posts at your booth. Best Booth Sign will win a prize! Last year's big winner was the Girls Softball Booth.
